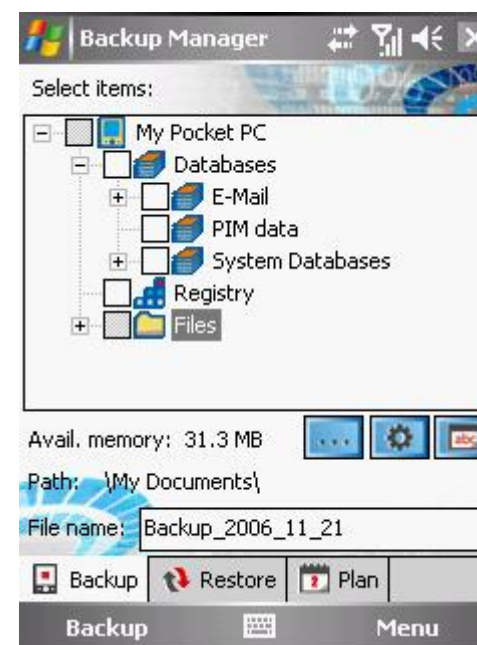

1. Log on to: <http://www.sunnysoft.com/registration.php>
2. Fill in all the fields required.
3. (Register name (ID): to be found in the application in your PDA. See *Start > Programs > Backup Manager > Menu > Register*. It is 16 character in total, combining pairs of digits and letter divided by dash. E.g. 77-fe-6a-66-4c-34-50-0b
Activation key: combines capital letters with numbers, in total 16 characters, four times four characters divided by dash. Will be found enclosed with installation CD or sent to you after completion of your order. E.g.2467-A6D5-05CD-542C.)
4. You will then receive automatically generated email from email address:registrace@sunnysoft.com which will contain the registration key that is needed to activate your application. The formate is the same as activation key.
5. **Enter** this **registration key** into the relevant fields **to activate your Sunnysoft Backup Manager**

Ad B/ To register online:

1. In order to be able to do this, you need to be connected to the internet.
2. On the registration screen, tick Online Registration.
3. Screen will after require your e-mail address and activation key. After entering this, your application will be activated. You will see the confirmation on you PDA screen.



BEFORE REGISTERING, please:


Make sure you enter the right digits and letters.

(Watch out for capital or small letters, look for difference between 0 [zero] or O [capital letter].)

Please, give us your name, email address that was given at registration and name and version of your software. Any other problem apart from registration difficulties, please state what kind of device you have and operation system you are running, together with software name and version of it.

Simple backup screen comes up as the first screen in the application. In this mode, destination for the backup file is automatically set to *My Documents*. It performs automatic, simple backup. Restart of your device is needed to start backup process. You can control the whole backup process visually as screen with smart bar indicating all details of backup will show time and detailed progress of backup process.

Settings option: tap the Setting button  on the screen if you wish to further define backup settings.

To backup: tap Backup button to initiate backup

Backup content: in simple mode Backup Manager performs complete system backup

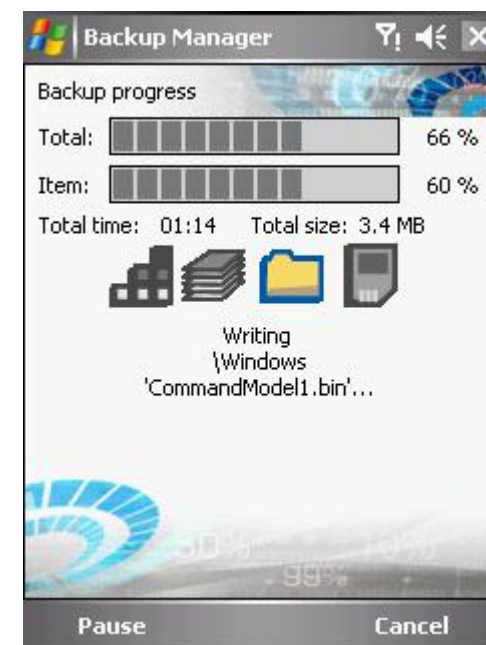
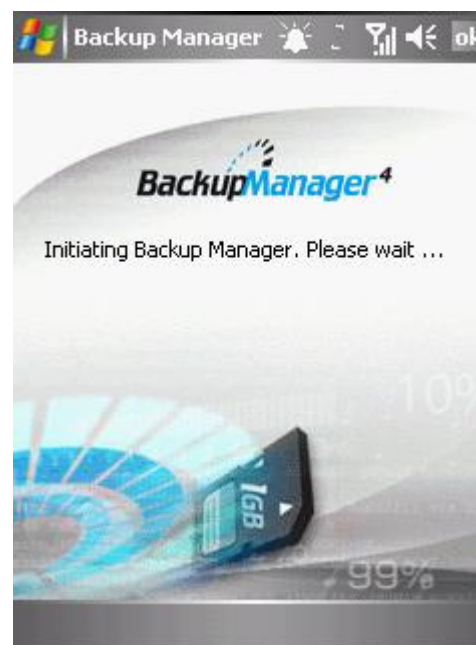


Confirm screen before backup

After your device performs soft reset backup process is initiated. Information about backup time, size and contents is displayed on the screen during backup process. When the process finishes, you can view complete backup log

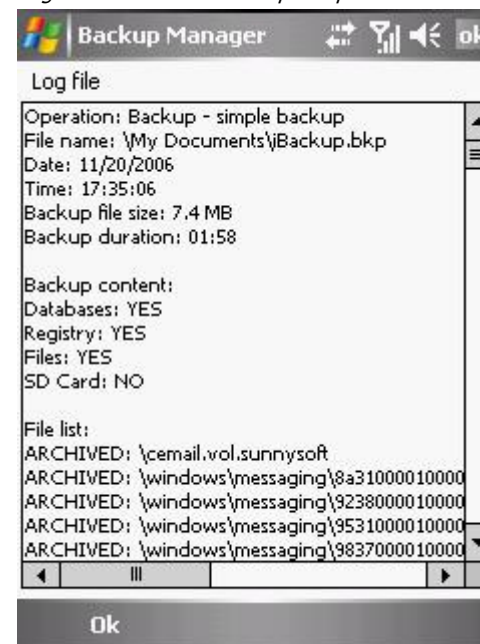
Initiating backup after soft reset

The following files will be saved in the destination folder on your PocketPC (My documents) as the result of executing the process. You will need to copy them in designed folder to your computer to be able to use them later, when you need to restore your data.

iBackup.bkp

key backup file that you need to keep for restore when needed, contains your data

iBackup.bkp.exe

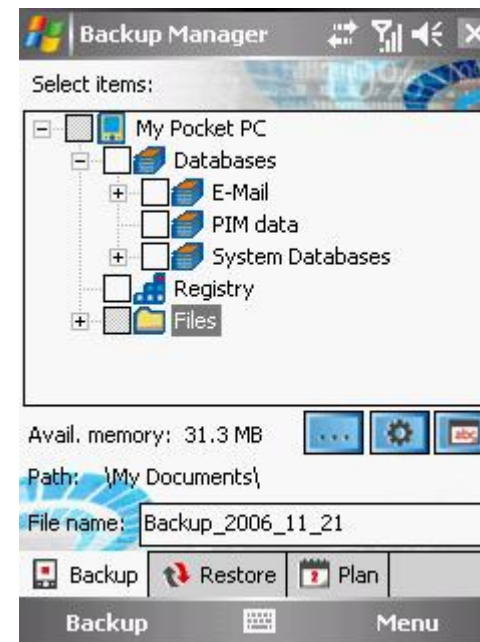
key backup file that you need to keep for restore when needed, executes the restores process

iBackup.bkp.log

to inform you sufficiently about the progress of backup process. You do not need to transfer it to your PC for later restore.

IV. ADVANCED MODE

A Advanced mode screen



Choice of three tabs, all with extended backup options:



- This advanced option lets you exactly define backup contents (> *Select items* -tick the items for backup).
- Shows available memory on your device.
- Gives you the following options:



Backup directory button:

tap to choose directory you want your backup file to be saved to



Settings button:

You can define backup features here



Note button:

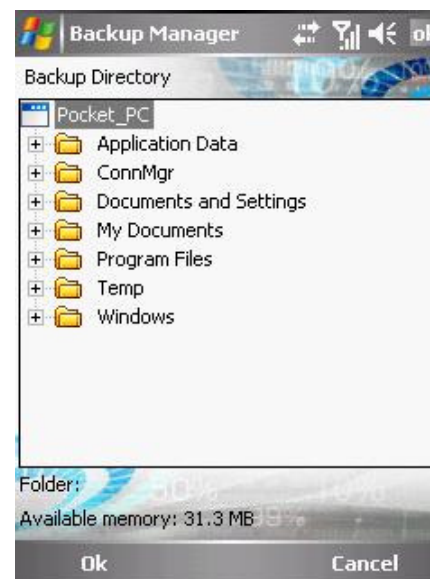
Here you can put any details you wish regarding backup

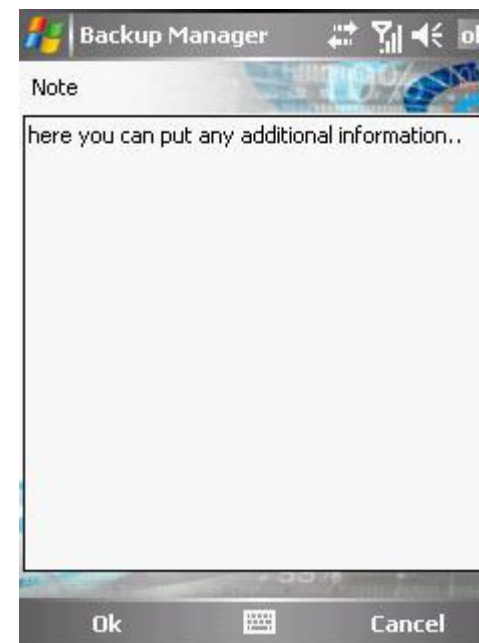

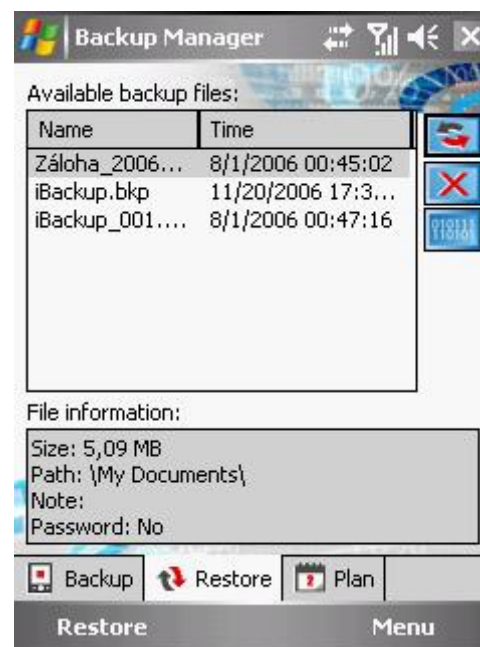
Note in Advanced mode



- Use this option under condition that you have already created a backup file and copied this backup file into your device.
- Here you can view the log of last backup and also get rid off backup files you do not wish to restore.
- After Restore, your device will restart.

When you tap on the Restore option at the bottom of the advanced mode screen, all files for restore will be found (*Looking for backup files*). You can then choose what exactly to restore (*Restore file log*). (Sometimes there are more backup files created when you backup regularly and tapping the refresh button  will bring up all backup files available). Tick items you wish to restore and tap "Restore". Backup Manager will restore chosen data (*Restore in progress*) and after that your device will be restarted.

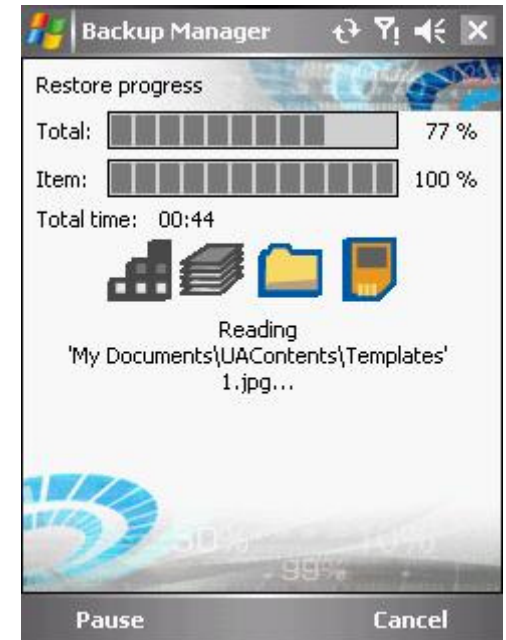

Restore in progress



Provides options to fully customize whole backup. You can precise the backup criteria as follows:


- A/ Scheduling
- B/ Battery plan
- Choose A/ and B/ at the same time for more secure and complete backup


If you tick the **Scheduling option** and tap its settings button  you will be able to define the following:

- Backup contents
- Backup days and time
- Define the backup directory tapping 
- ***Also you can opt to initiate a daily backup every time the device is switched on.***
- After setting this criteria and tapping OK, confirmation will appear first on the screen and after all will display on the *Backup planning screen*.



Plan

If you tick **Battery plan option** and tap its settings button  you will be able to define the following:

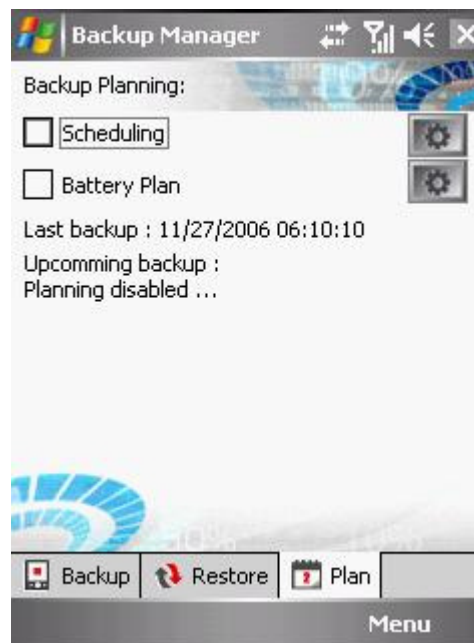
- Backup contents
- Set the limit for battery level at which backup will be performed
- Set the interval for battery backup (from min.15min period to max.360min)
- Define the backup directory tapping 
- After setting this criteria and tapping OK, confirmation will appear first on the screen and after all will display on the Backup planning screen.



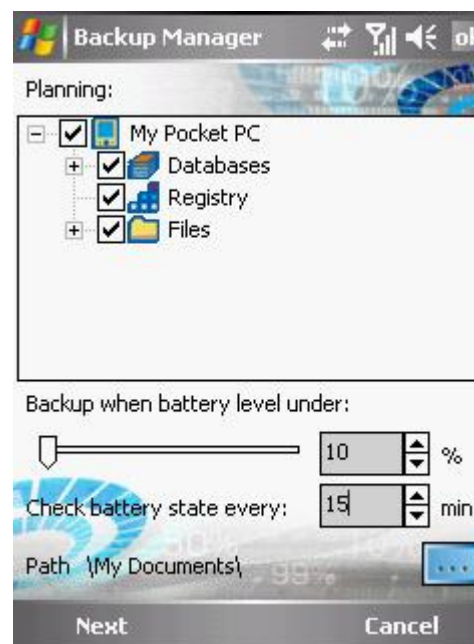

The Backup Planning screen also shows the last backup performed.

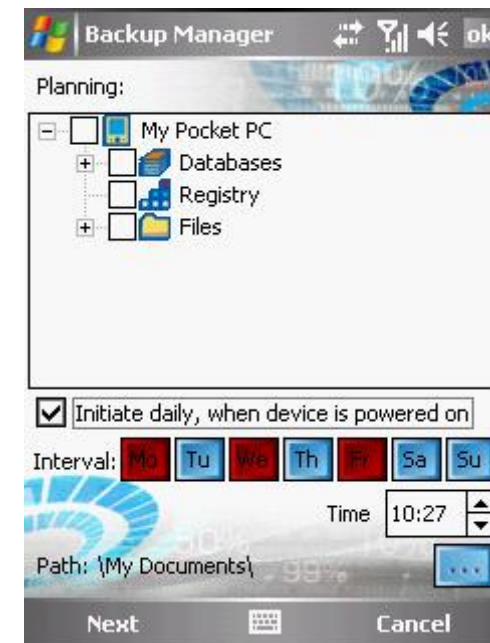
Backup planning screen



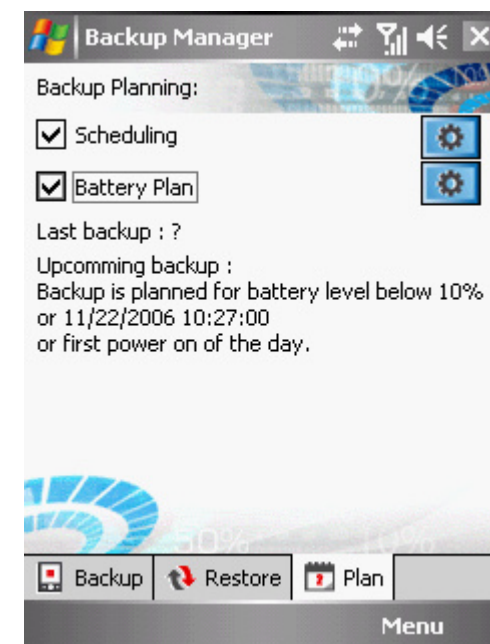
Battery plan screen in Backup Planning



Scheduling screen in Advanced Planning

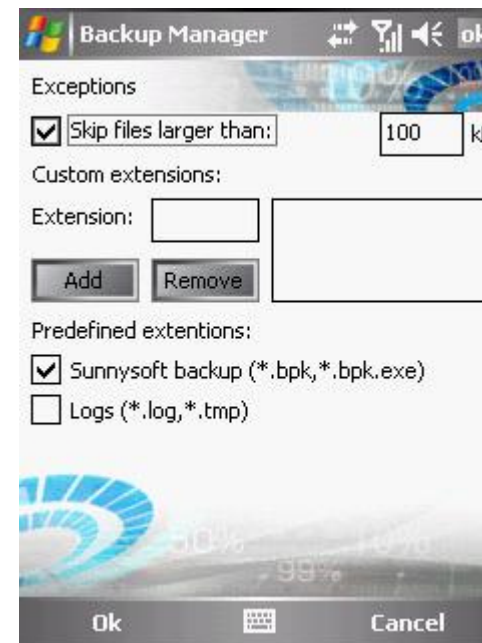

V. BACKUP EXCEPTIONS

Backup exceptions screen



Here you can specify which files should not be the part of backup file:

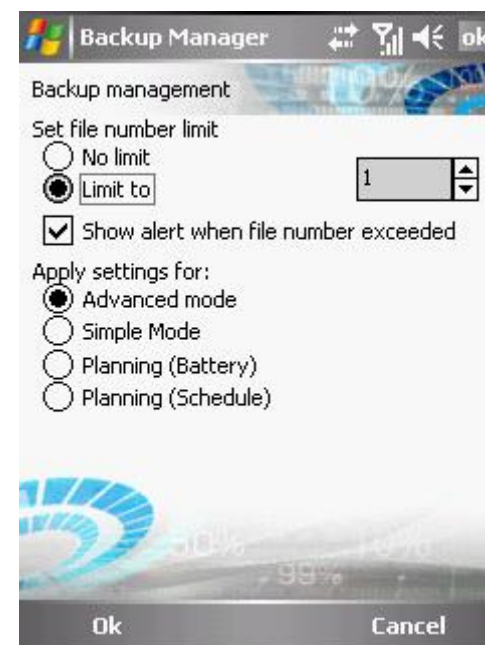
- ***You can skip files that are larger than xx kB.***

You can define:

- Files that should be skipped that have certain extensions - ***Custom extensions***
- Backup Manager will not backup files with predefined extensions given on the screen in **Predefined extensions** section if the boxes are ticked. Default setting in this case says that previous Sunnysoft Backup files (these have default extensions from the developer- .bpb, .bpb.exe) will not be included in the latest backup. If you choose to tick the second box, file carrying the log information about backup progress will no be saved (.log) and also any temporary files will be excluded (.tmp).

VI. BACKUP MANAGEMENT

This part will help you the whole backup more easily for example enabling you to set the limit for backup files that should be kept (otherwise the application will keep all backup files, even the ones that you do not need and which you will otherwise have to delete manually).



VII. SELECTION

Clear current

- quickly clears up all selections that you have selected up to now.

As last backup

- remembers your last backup settings and automatically makes the selections for you again.

VIII. EXIT

Exits the application quickly back to Programs screen
