## SOFTWARE INSTALLATION AND COMPATIBILITY

*KwikMaps* requires Palm OS version 4.0 or higher to work. The application file is *KwikMaps.prc* and can be installed either using Palm Desktop and Hotsync or through direct transfer to device (infrared, Bluetooth or over-the-air). However, please read the “License and Disclaimer” section carefully.

In order to upgrade from a previous version, you simply have to install this new version onto your handheld, without removing the former. User preferences are kept untouched when upgrading.

## APPLICATION DESCRIPTION

- *KwikMaps* allows you to select an address from the application screen and within *Contacts* application and loads a map in your web browser on in *GoogleMaps* application, showing the location of the selected address. An Internet connection is required for your handheld/smartphone to load the map.
- Open *KwikMaps* to select the **browser** to be used (a web browser or *GoogleMaps* application) and the **website**<sup>1</sup> to be queried for maps (currently supported services are: [Google Maps](#), [MapQuest Mobile](#) and [Maporama Wireless](#)). *KwikMaps* will remember your selections for future uses.
- *KwikMaps* offers two ways to get the map for a contact's address:
  - ➔ Tap on **Lookup map now** to see the list of your contacts and their addresses<sup>2</sup>. Select a contact and tap **Map** button. *KwikMaps* will open the browser and load the map for the selected address.
  - ➔ If *KwikMaps* is installed into device memory (not on a card), it can also cooperate with *Contacts* application (formerly called *Address Book*), which is present on most Palm OS devices. In the contact details view, open **Record** menu, then tap **Connect**<sup>3</sup>. You will see a list of available services for Quick Connect. Tap on the contact's **address** and *KwikMaps* will open the browser and load the map for the selected address.

## DEVICE/BROWSER COMPATIBILITY INFORMATION

- Before trying *KwikMaps* with your specific device and browser, read this and the following sections carefully, especially “License and Disclaimer”.
- Your browser (or *GoogleMaps* application) must be installed into device memory (not on a card) in order to be recognized by *KwikMaps*.
- *KwikMaps* has been tested with the following web browsers:
  - ➔ *Blazer (Web)* 3 and 4 (Netfront-based), preloaded in recent Palm devices (e.g. Treo 600, Lifedrive and T|X). It works fine with all supported map services.
  - ➔ *PalmSource Web Browser* (Netfront-based): it displays maps correctly on MapQuest Mobile and Maporama Wireless websites.
  - ➔ *Xiino* 3.4: it displays maps correctly on MapQuest Mobile website.
  - ➔ *Universe*: it displays maps correctly on MapQuest Mobile website<sup>4</sup>.

1 Please note that, if you select *GoogleMaps* as browser, website selection is not required.

2 Unfortunately, if more than one address is present for a contact, only the first one will be shown in the list.

3 Unfortunately, *Contacts* application in latest Treo smartphones – Treo 600 and later models – lacks this feature

4 Please note that it is a product in beta stage and still under development, so wider compatibility is expected for the first stable release.

- ➔ *iPanel* (formerly known as *EIS Web*): it displays maps correctly on MapQuest Mobile website.
- ➔ *AvantGo* 6.0. It opens the map page correctly, but causes a soft reset (no harm for user data) when exiting. It seems a bug not related with *KwikMaps* in particular, but with *AvantGo* itself; further investigation is being performed.
- ➔ *Eudora Web*. Latest version (2.1) does not support images, so the web page is loaded correctly but map is not displayed.
- According to user reports, *KwikMaps* works also with the following web browsers:
  - ➔ *Netfront* 3.1, preloaded in several Sony CLIE models: it displays maps correctly on MapQuest Mobile website.
  - ➔ *NWeb*, available for some Palm OS devices (e.g. Samsung i500 smartphone on Sprint networks and Zodiac handhelds): it works fine with all supported map services.
- *KwikMaps* may also work with the following web browsers, though testing could not be performed due to lack of devices<sup>1</sup>:
  - ➔ *Blazer* 1.0/2.0 (Treo models older than 600)
  - ➔ *Novarra Web Pro* (for older Palm devices, e.g. Tungsten T<sup>2</sup>)
- *KwikMaps* can also use *GoogleMaps* application to load maps.
