A. Launch the App.



B. Choose a memo.



C. Tap on Choose Again.

What it does

This little application for PalmOS® devices will read a list of names (or anything else) from a Memo pad file, display the list, and randomly highlight one of the names. Each time the user taps the Choose Again button, another name will be highlighted randomly.

Why it does it

Classroom teachers and seminar leaders who want to enhance student participation and learning should often call on students to respond. It is best to call on all students and to do so randomly. You can think of myriad occasions on which to make random choices.

How to do it

1. Create a list using the PalmOS Memo pad. Every item should appear on a different line or in a separate paragraph. There may be empty line spaces between items.
2. Launch the NamePick application. (See A above).
3. The names of all the memos will appear in a selection window. Click on one of them. (See B above.)
4. Tap on Start.
5. All the names or items in the Memo pad file will appear in another Selection list. One of them will be highlighted. (See C above.)
6. To randomly choose other names or items in the list, tap on the Choose Again button.

Name Pick was written and compiled in CASL 3.3 and requires the CASLrt.prc run-time module.
