Registering WV Solitaires

WV Solitaires is downloadable shareware. Its registered copy costs \$9.95. The demo version is completely functional but you can play only 20 days. **After purchasing the game, you will receive a registration key.**

After purchasing the product you will receive a registration key. To register this program first tap on the Menu silkscreen button. Then, select Help, and tap Registration. Finally, enter your Registration Key on the space provided.



When you tap the logo screen a list of the games will appear. Tap the name of the game you would like to play and enjoy!




The games

Spider

The goal of the game is to remove all the cards from the playing field by arranging them in descending order from K to A by suit. If you want to deal, tap on the cards in the lower left corner.



You can choose the difficulty level: one, two or four suits from the Preferences of the game.





Klondike

The goal of the game is to arrange the cards from A to K in suits.

You can arrange the cards in the lower positions in descending order if they are from different suits.

If you want additional cards, tap on the cards store in the upper right corner.




Preferences: you can choose how many cards to be drawn when you tap on the cards store - one or three.




FreeCell

The goal is to arrange the cards by suit from A to K in the four vacant positions in the upper right corner.




You can arrange the cards in the lower positions in descending order if they are from different suits. You can use the four vacant positions in the upper left corner as a temporary storage of the cards.




LeapFrog

The goal: there should remain only one card on the playing field.




You can remove the cards by gathering two of a suit or two with one and the same value. You can move a card horizontally, vertically or diagonally, but you have to jump over one card. You can get additional cards from card storage in the upper right corner.




BlackHole

You should gather all the cards in the bottom right corner.




You can put a card in the bottom right corner if its value is greater or smaller by one than the value of the card that is already there.




Yukon

Arrange the cards by suit from A to K in the four vacant positions, situated in the upper left corner.




You can move a card or a group of cards and you can arrange them in descending order, but only when the card you are putting on is different suit. You can put only K on a vacant position.




Towers

Arrange the cards by suit from A to K in the four vacant positions, situated in the upper right corner.



You can arrange the cards in the lower positions in descending order if they are from one and the same suit.

You can use the four vacant positions in the upper left corner as a temporary storage of the cards. You can move only the top card from each column.




Pyramid

You should remove all the cards from the pyramid.



You can remove the cards in couples, but only if the sum of their values is 13 and they are not covered with other cards. It is possible to remove a covered card and the one that is covering it if the sum of their values is 13. K can be removed on its own. You can use the additional cards, situated in the bottom left corner, to remove a card from the pyramid with the top additional card, if it is possible. You can also remove the top card from the additional cards and the one below it, if the sum of their values is 13. The values of the cards are as follows: A - 1, 2 - 2 J - 11, Q - 12, K - 13.



Help

Solitaires offer some simplified internal help. You can find there some basic information of the rules of the game and its final goal.

To view these tips go to **Menu|Help|Help**. The following screen will appear:



Tap **Done** to quit the screen.
